# Milestones & Achievements



## SUD and Nuestra Clinica Education & Prevention Programs

- Completed a **\$160K renovation** of the 3.5 Level of Care NCR facility
- Deployed a new **electronic health record system**
- Served **4,318** individuals, enrolling 10 new clients in the Ryan White Part B Medical Case Management Program
- Partnered with **FHCCP** to expand access to women's health products for pregnant and parenting women



## WLCH AM & FM Radio Centro

- **Expanded Regional Reach:** New 107.1 FM boosted coverage and improved access for Latino communities across Lancaster, York, and Harrisburg.
- **Growing Engagement:** Increased listenership and strengthened partnerships with sponsors to provide vital support for educational and cultural programming.
- **Cultural & Community Impact:** FIESTA 2025 and focused programming on health, financial literacy, and civic engagement position WLCH as a trusted resource and cultural hub.



## SACA Development

- **Renovated 5 homes; sold 4** to new owners
- **\$1.3M upgrade** to Tec Centro West welding/fabrication training space
- **\$850K renovation** of Apartments at General Cigar Place



## Human Services

- **34,494** hot meals served in 2025 (12/1/2024–12/1/2025)
- **55** new Senior Center participants, with expanded exercise and nutrition programming
- **160** individuals supported through Human Services Case Management, totaling **351+** hours of personalized assistance



## Tec Centro Workforce Development

- January marked Tec Centro West's **10-year anniversary** and full renovation.
- **New Program:** Launched Renewable Energy Construction Technology with Thaddeus Stevens; first cohort began in August.
- **Record Year:** HISET graduated a record 60 adult learners.
